GENERAL RULES

Hard hats/crash hats kite marked and correctly adjusted and
FASTENED, must be worn AT ALL TIMES whilst mounted.

The organisers reserve the right to limit or refuse entries if deemed necessary without giving any reason. Classes will be closed at their discretion; the organisers' decision is final.

Objections may only be made in writing to the secretary; not more than half an hour after the class has finished, accompanied by a £10 deposit which will be forfeited if the objection is over ruled. The organisers' decision is final.

All trophies are to be held for one year. Recipients are responsible for their safe return

The organisers have taken all precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone on the day. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must follow the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.

No horses/ponies are to be left tied up to trailers/lorries and left unattended.

Anyone considered to be riding dangerously or in an abusive manner will be asked to leave the showground.
